



Why Take the GED?



People with a high school diploma or high school diploma equivalent earn an average of \$179

per week more than those without a high school diploma.

Ask yourself: What personally motivates me to take the GED?

Check Your Eligibility

Must be a Texas resident and provide photo identification		
You will be asked to prove residency at testing center the day of the test		
The state accepts both national and foreign government issued identification, such as a driver's license, military ID, or passport.		
Must not currently enrolled in high school		
Must be at least 18 years old		
Residents may test at age 17 with parent or guardian permission if they're not currently enrolled in school.		
Students may also test at age 16 if they're in the care of a Texas state agency or under a court order.

Score Ranges of the GED

Each subject on GED on a scale of 100-200 points. In order to pass the GED, you must earn 145 points for each subject, adding up to a total of least 580 points out of 800 points.





Retest (if needed)


If you don't end up passing the GED on the first try, you have the option to retest.

It costs \$16.25 per subject retest.

In Texas, there is no waiting period if you do not pass a subject area test the first time.

After taking a test subject 3 times, you'll have to wait 60 days before retesting. There's no limit to how many times you can test in a year.

Use this chart to track your progress on your GED adventure! Fill your current score in each section.




Northeast Houston GED Classes, Registration, and Libraries

Yellow squares – HCC GED class locations **Red stars** – HCC GED registration locations




Northwest Houston GED Classes, Registration, and Libraries

Yellow squares – HCC GED class locations Red stars – HCC GED registration locations




Southeast Houston GED Classes, Registration, and Libraries







You will receive an email with information on how to get either piece of information then come back to this screen to log in.

However, it's likely you've never been here before which means you need to create an account. Click on the "Create an Account" link on the left side of the screen.








If you have not taken any of the GED® tests on computer, select the top link (you also want to select the top link if you have taken some tests on paper). However, if you have taken some GED® tests on computer, select the bottom link and you can get your account information.









One of the first questions is a little tricky: "What is your identification number type?"






Now you are back at the screen with all the circles. You have a few more questions to answer before you can schedule your GED® test. Click on the half-shaded #2 circle again.

There are a couple of confusing questions here too.


The question that asks: "Did you take the Official GED Practice Test™?" Most likely if you took a practice test in class, you took this test, so go ahead and answer yes. You can also buy this test online, so if you did this you will also answer yes. If you don't remember taking a practice test go ahead and answer no.

Another confusing question asks: "Do you need to request modified testing conditions for a documented disability?" Most people will answer NO to this question. However, if you've seen a doctor and have a diagnosed disability such as a learning disability and have proof from a doctor you will select YES to this question. If you answer yes, you will have to wait for further approval to continue scheduling your GED® test.

Once you complete all the questions, scroll to the bottom of the screen and click "Submit Form."








Now you are registered and can schedule one or more of your GED® tests. Click the #3 circle to begin scheduling.





Eligibility Requirements for High School Equivalency Testing

A resident of the state who has not graduated from an accredited high school is eligible to take the high school equivalency test per <u>Texas Education Code</u>, <u>Section 7.111</u> in accordance with rules promulgated by the State Board of Education. Eligibility requirements for high school equivalency testing are defined in the <u>Texas Administrative Code</u>, <u>Title 19</u>, <u>Part 2</u>, <u>Chapter 89</u>, <u>Subchapter C</u>, <u>Rule §89.43</u>.

High School Equivalency Test Requirements:

In order to take the high school equivalency exams, the test-taker must:

- have a government (national or foreign) issued photo ID, such as one of the following:
 - state driver license.
 - Department of Public Safety identification card,
 - o military ID,
 - o passport,
 - U.S. passport card, or
 - matrícula consular;

(School ID cards will not be accepted)

- provide proof of residency in Texas, which could be a:
 - Texas driver license,
 - utility bill showing a Texas address, or
 - bank statement showing a Texas address;
- be 18 years of age;
- not be enrolled in an accredited high school; and
- not be a high school graduate from an accredited high school.

Age Exceptions

Individuals under the age of 18 are required to attend school (Texas Education Code <u>Chapter 25, Section 25.085</u>) unless they qualify for an exemption (Texas Education Code <u>Chapter 25, Section 25.086</u>).

17-Year-Old Test-Takers

To qualify for an age exception, a 17-year-old must:

- have a government (national or foreign) issued photo ID (see above for ID requirements);
- have proof of Texas residency (see above for residency requirements);
- verify you are not currently enrolled in school (unless enrolled in an approved in-school High School Equivalency Program);

- not have an accredited high school diploma; and
- have parent or guardian permission.

Alternatively, a 17-year-old may qualify under the 16-year-old rule below.

16-Year-Old Test-Takers

To qualify for an age exception, a 16-year-old must:

- have a government (national or foreign) issued photo ID (see above for ID requirements);
- have proof of Texas residency (see above for residency requirements);
- · not have an accredited high school diploma; and
- be one of the following:
 - in the care of a state agency;
 - under a court order issued under Family Code 65.103 (a) (3);
 - enrolled in a Job Corps training program, or
 - enrolled in the Texas Challenge Academy.
